## Assist Future Research & Clinical Practice

### A New Measure for Tracking Thinking Skills & Behavior



This research seeks to test online questionnaires and assessments of different thinking skills and behaviors.

If successful, this project will be the first step towards offering measures to clinical specialists and researchers to improve our ability to understand a variety of genetic disorders related disorders including WDR26.

#### **Eligibility**

- WDR26 diagnosis.
- Between the ages of 2 60
- A participating parent or other knowledgeable information provider.
- Access to a reliable internet connection.
- Access to a tablet, laptop, or desktop computer with a webcam.
- English is the primary spoken language.

#### • Research Method:

The participating parent/caregiver will be asked to complete online surveys about the participant.

Participants will be asked to test new online video assessments that collect important clinical information from the comfort of home.

Both the video assessment and survey will be given 5 times; at the start of the study, 3 months later, 6 months later, 9 months later, and 12 months later.
